Today we will hear of God's Gospel of forgiveness from the intriguing account of Mary—whose brother Lazarus was raised from the dead—anointing Jesus' feet with perfume as he prepares for his death (John 12:1-11).

Help needed for Maundy Thursday and Good Friday services:

On **Maundy Thursday** we will be 'stripping the altar' after the service in a short ceremony to signify Christ's humiliation and suffering during his passion (Psalm 22:18). During the ceremony on Maundy Thursday, some people will be needed to help carry items from the sanctuary to the rooms either side (the altar and sanctuary area will subsequently be entirely bare on Good Friday). We will have a brief run through at 6:30 Maundy Thursday 24 March.

On **Good Friday** a few extra Bible readers are needed as we tell the account of the Passion of Christ from John's Gospel. Please let Pastor Matt or John Zadow know if you can help out in either or both of these ways.

20th March After the fire (Interview)


Hear stories from people who have lived through a major fire bushfire. Hear about what they experienced the day the fires hit and how they've coped years down the track,

- That all our members who are sick and in need of healing, or who are dealing with difficult life circumstances, may experience joy that comes with trust in God (Psalm 126:5-6).


